

Dear Friends of OpenMinds,

The Executive Committee of OpenMinds met on November 20, 2019, ahead of the General Assembly. The overriding emphasis was on OpenMinds' ability to tread the difficult waters our beloved country is currently experiencing, and its ability to manage the potential reverberations in the foreseeable future. During such times of acute need, our foremost concern is ensuring that OpenMinds' charitable contributions to needy families by way of medical therapies and scholarship packages remain intact. This is in line with our contingency planning and with our efforts to ensure sustainability with limited or no "fresh funds".

Thanks to your unwavering generosity throughout the years, coupled with our extremely prudent financial policies, we would like to communicate with you how we plan on ensuring continuity of services as per the following decisions taken and approved by the General Assembly:

- Financial Packages awarded to needy families at the AUBMC Special Kids Clinic- These packages shall remain unchanged, as more families will inevitably struggle with finances.
- 2. Schools and Awareness- The Scholarship budget shall in fact be increased by 20%, to reflect the extreme and dire demand we are experiencing from students with Special Needs in schools throughout Lebanon. Moreover, while integration commitments made to schools prior to 2020 will be honored, any new substantial undertakings will be halted for now.
- 3. **Neurodevelopmental Research at AUBMC-** OpenMinds will only continue to support the research projects that were previously entered into, and their publication.
- 4. Operational expenses shall remain limited to the already extremely low overhead levels we currently incur (under 9%). Communication shall be restricted to the basic needs of OpenMinds, and all media campaigns that were planned will be reduced to a strict minimum so that funds can be better allocated in line with the above.
- 5. There was discussion about the possibility of fundraising internationally, should local annual galas remain unfeasible. The PQASSO quality accreditation process that OpenMinds is currently undergoing should strengthen the success of such endeavors.
